

# Keighley Target Sports Membership Form

## *Notes for Applicants*

- 1/ Any applicant for membership will become a probationary member for a period of 26 weeks or 13 weeks if already a current firearms certificate holder or member of another shooting club.
- 2/ Applicants under the age of 16 must be supervised by a parent or guardian over the age of 21 whilst on club premises. There is no minimum age, but juniors are admitted at the discretion of the club.
- 3/ All applicants must provide 2 referees (please see/download referee form) who have known the applicant for a minimum 2 years and are not family members. These referees will be contacted before new applicants will be allowed to come and shoot at the club.
- 4/ Applicants will be contacted after references have been followed up and informed that they can shoot at the club. This will be by email or letter which must be brought on the first visit to the club along with a signed membership form, signed Section 21 declaration, 2 passport sized pictures and both completed referee forms.
- 5/ All new applications are to be accompanied by photographic proof of identification in the form of a photocopy or scan of either your passport or photo driving license or other suitable photo ID. If you cannot supply one of these as proof of identification, then a passport size photograph certified by one of your referees and a utility bill not more than 3 months old will be required. For online applications scans or good quality photographs may be supplied in jpeg or pdf format.  
For junior members who do not possess a suitable photo ID, the parent or guardian should supply theirs.
- 6/ After the probationary period the applicant may be considered for full membership.  
Probationers who, without good cause, have not attended at least 12 times within their probationary period will not be considered for full membership.
- 7/ Any probationary member who, without good cause, does not attend for 10 consecutive weeks will be considered lapsed.
- 8/ Any full member not attending at least twice in a 12 month period, without good cause, will be considered lapsed.
- 9/ Lapsed members may reapply to become a probationer, but may have to rejoin a waiting list.
- 10/ All members (full and probationary) must sign the attendance register on each visit,
- 11/ Probationary members must also ensure that their probationer's attendance card is signed by the range officer on duty or a committee member.
- 12/ All applicants must supply two passport size photographs or a good quality digital photo if applying online.
- 13/ The fee for probationary membership is £30, which is non refundable. The fee is payable on the first visit to the club if application.
- 14/ The fee for full membership is £180 per year for adults and £102 for juniors. Memberships start on the 1st of April each year, for new full members the fee due will be the pro rata amount from the date of approval for full membership until the next 31st of March.
- 15/ Full membership subscriptions may be paid monthly, but membership is annual and the full or pro rata amount until the next 31st of March is still payable if a member leaves.
- 16/ Deliberately supplying incorrect or misleading information on this form is grounds for immediate expulsion from the club.
- 17/ Wherever possible communication regarding membership will be made via email.
- 18/ All forms should be emailed to [contact@keighleytargetsports.com](mailto:contact@keighleytargetsports.com).
- 19/ Application forms may not be handed in at the club. Once you have been informed that you can shoot all completed paperwork and 2 passport sized pictures should be brought to the club on your first visit.

There is a requirement that all prospective members must sign a declaration that that they are not prohibited from possessing a firearm or ammunition in contravention of section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968 which states:-

It is an offence for someone who is prohibited by section 21 to have a firearm (including air guns) or ammunition in their possession at any time. Section 21 applies to any person who has been sentenced to imprisonment or to youth custody or detention in a young offender institute for three months or more. The period for which they are prohibited depends on the length of sentence. If the sentence was for 3 years or more the prohibition is for life. If the sentence was for more than 3 months but less than 3 years, the prohibition lasts for 5 years from the date of release. It is an offence for a person to transfer, let or hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone known or suspected with reasonable grounds, to be prohibited under section 21.

I declare that I have read and understood the above, and that I am not prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition by section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968.
